Details of Asking for Forgiveness from God

Begin with this prayer:

"Lord show me who has sinned against me.

Lord show me how I have sinned against others."

What God reveals, deal with it.

- 1. Acknowledge your feelings. I felt angry, little, insignificant, like I didn't matter, rejected, invisible...
- 2. List the specific sin... they sinned against me by lying about me. I sinned against them by lying about them.
- 3. Say the words: God I forgive them or God please forgive me
- 4. Receive God's forgiveness. Do not brush it aside. Live in the wonder that your sins have been forgiven.
- 5. Tell God your action plan not to sin again in this way again.

Details of Asking for Forgiveness from Others

So what does a conversation sound like where you ask for forgiveness? Here are some steps:

- 1. Set aside a time when you can be alone, without distractions with time to talk it through.
- 2. When you meet, ask the person to tell you how you hurt them.
- 3. Listen—don't defend your actions or sidestep or blame her (write them down if needed).
- 4. If s/he gets quiet, say you are listening and ask if there is more.
- 5. Ask them specifically to forgive you for each offense you committed.
 "I know I hurt you and disappointed you by my actions. I know I sinned against you and God and I want to change so I never do it again. Please forgive me."
- 6. Add more sins if they are brought up. Own your sins, don't explain.
- 7. Rather than demanding their trust immediately, accept that as your consequence.
- 8. Tell your plan to not sin against them again. Include put-offs, put-ons and attitude changes.
- 9. Maybe ask for another meeting in a week or a month to get input on how you are doing.
